

## Introduction, Marty Morgenstern

Marty Morgenstern was appointed Director of Personnel Administration, State of CA, by Gov. Gray Davis in January 1999 and served until November of 2003 when Governor Davis left office.

Earlier he had served the University of California and California government as:

Morgenstern got his start in labor management relations as shop steward at the East Harlem Welfare Center in N.Y.C. in 1964 and has been working, speaking, writing and lecturing in this field ever since.
