WHO IS BOB:

Bob Orange–President Emeritus: Warden for 29 years, currently covering Plumas and Lassen Counties. BA Geography, CSU Chico. Certified from CSUC in EIR Analysis and Reporting. AA Administration of Justice, Feather River College. Formerly employed with the US Forest Service as Fire Fighter/Apparatus Engineer for 5 years and continued on as a volunteer fireman. Former EMT; CPR and First Aid Instructor. Certified Open Water Diver, recipient of Director’s Achievement Award for environmental prosecution and the Lifesaving Award. Worked undercover with DFG Special Operations Unit (SOU) in the black market trade of wildlife and Marine Patrol. Has also been on Animal Planet along with Warden Karnow in the exposure of bear poaching. Currently involved in production of an upcoming Warden documentary aimed at PBS and Reality TV. Bob was honored as the Volunteer Firefighter Of The Year by CDF and Tehama County Fire. Has served as President, Vice-President, and is current Board Member of the California Fish & Game Wardens Association (CFGWA).



A second generation Game Warden, his father retired with 38 years at DFG after serving with the US Navy in the Pacific Theater of WWII. Mother retired from United States Forest Service (USFS). Bob’s sister and brother-in-law were killed by a drunk driver. Orange is married with two sons and a daughter. Oldest son works as an Engineer with the USFS and is finalizing studies at CSU, Chico. Youngest son attended CSU, Sacramento and is currently a Firefighter on a USFS Engine as well as being a EMT & Ambulance driver in Sacramento. Daughter graduated from CSU Chico, is married and teaches High School Special Education in Plumas County. Bob’s son-in-law has a BA in Criminal Justice and is a Probation Officer for the County of Plumas. Has two grandchildren. Bob’s wife has a BA in Social Studies from CSU Sacramento. She was a Social Worker for 32 years until forced to retire after she was bucked off a horse breaking her back in several locations. She remains paralyzed.

Bob has testified repeatedly in budget and committee hearings in the Senate and Assembly at the Capitol. He worked with the Legislature where he was a instrumental part of obtaining the \$30 million allocation in pay increases for BU 7 members in the last contract. In the process Bob has helped build a solid relationship with the Administration and Legislature, and all without PAC funds! In August of 2007, Orange was honored by the California State Senate with a bi-partisan Resolution commending him for his work with the Legislature in advocating for awareness, pay and benefits for officers.
