Notice: Do not suffer a lapse in your Legal Defense Fund Coverage!

For those former CSLEA members who elected to opt out of membership and drop their CSLEA Legal Defense Fund coverage, this is a courtesy notice to prevent any lapse in your legal defense coverage. You may have received a letter from Peace Officers of California (POC) advising that the law firm which was singularly responsible for providing POC's LDF coverage has elected to terminate their retainer with POC (and its LDF members) effective January 31, 2012.

Although POC has represented that it hoped to renegotiate an extension or find an alternative provider of legal defense coverage, that is unlikely to occur. Thus, CSLEA is taking this step to notify former CSLEA members who joined POC the prudence of obtaining LDF through CSLEA. For those who would like to re-apply as CSLEA members and take advantage of CSLEA's LDF (which is modeled after and utilizes many of the same attorneys and firms as PORAC's LDF) you can apply on-line at www.cslea.com and click on "JOIN NOW". If it is too costly to continue to be a member of POC as well, you may want to use the attached letter (link to letter at the bottom of this email) to cancel your membership with POC.
