To whom it may concern,

The latest Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the State of California and the California Statewide Law Enforcement Association (CSLEA) expired on June 30, 2008. In the absence of a successor MOU or a declaration of impasse by the Public Employment Relations Board (PERB), CSLEA is required to give effect to all provisions of the expired MOU on a day to day basis. Therefore, within the limits of Article 3, Sec 3.1 A. 1, I have resigned my membership within CSLEA, effective immediately. As you should be aware, it is illegal for any labor organization to force any person to be represented by said labor organization. All State employees shall have the right to represent themselves with their employer. Further, CSLEA appears to be in criminal violation of Section 146c of the Penal Code, something I am forbidden to participate in as a sworn peace officer. I am therefore withdrawing any legal authority they previously held to my current payroll deduction.

Please find enclosed the following three documents:

- (1) My CSLEA Letter of Resignation.
- (2) My AMVIC Letter of Resignation.
- (3) My Objection to Fees (Hudson) Letter.

I respectfully request that your Unit *immediately* adjust my CSLEA payroll deduction to pay only the minimum fair share agency fee and have my dues reduced accordingly to **\$33.17 per month**. Please do not adjust my deferred compensation deduction.

If there is some reason why my dues will not be adjusted according to my demands as soon as practically possible by your unit, please phone me at (619) xxx-xxxx, or write me at the above-listed address so that I may review this information with counsel.
