Dear Mr. Barcelona,

At this time I am requesting a hearing in regards to the Notice of Intent to Take Disciplinary Action against me.

This action by CSLEA to discipline me is a violation of both section 3519.5(b) of the Ralph C. Dills Act and Article 2.6 of the BU7 MOU. With that in mind, CSLEA should have no problem violating Section B(5) of the CSLEA Constitution which states: "The charging party will have the right to present testimony, the right to select a person of his/her own choosing, who is a member of or officer of CSLEA, to present the case." I therefore demand that the complainant/accuser/charging party be present during the hearing to give testimony. I also insist that, prior to the hearing, I am provided with a description of the charges and accusations that are much more specific in detail and nature than the very vague and very loosely based on fact accusations in the original notice.

This hearing request will be mailed on 10/24/08. Its timely arrival prior to the 10/31/08 deadline set by CSLEA will serve as evidence of my intent to attend the hearing. Should CSLEA be unwilling to meet the above demands in regard to said hearing, I expect that CSLEA, in good faith, advise me by mail of their refusal or inability to comply, thereby postponing the deadline of my request or response and allowing me to either accept the conditions of the hearing or offer a written response in my defense.
