RE: Disciplinary Hearing

Dear Mr. Clark,

This letter is to inform you that I am unable to appear before the CSLEA Disciplinary Hearing Committee on the date selected by the committee (12/8/08). Due to time constraints I am unavailable until the end of January. I have checked my schedule and am available on 1/29/09. I request my hearing be moved to this date. This extension request will arrive per your instructions no later than fifteen days prior to the original hearing date, therefore, it is reasonable to assume that your demand for my Statement of Defenses which is also required within the same time frame, will be extended until no later than 15 days prior to January 29, 2009.

The above requested extension should also allow CSLEA to address demands which I stated in my original hearing request, of which CSLEA has made no mention to date.

Please address the following demands from my previous hearing request:

"...I therefore demand that the complainant/accuser/charging party be present during the hearing to give testimony. I also insist that, prior to the hearing, I am provided with a description of the charges and accusations that are much more specific in detail and nature than the very vague and very loosely based on fact accusations in the original notice.

... Should CSLEA be unwilling to meet the above demands in regard to said hearing, I expect that CSLEA, in good faith, advise me by mail of their refusal or inability to comply, thereby postponing the deadline of my request or response and allowing me to either accept the conditions of the hearing or offer a written response in my defense."

I will, with reservation, send a "temporary" Statement of Defenses until such time as CSLEA can provide me with a list of factual charges that I can address. These charges should include actual times, dates, statements supposedly made. I will need to receive a copy of the original complaint brought on me from the complainant Ranger. Again, I request CSLEA address the above underlined demands and respond to me.
